Flood Aid Registration Deadlines Are Now October 2

Deadlines to register for assistance to help aid recovery from losses due to the late-June severe storms and flooding have been extended. Registrations for the New York State Individual and Family Grant Program, programs administered by Empire State Development Corporation, and federal aid including SBA disaster loans will now be accepted until Monday, October 2.
